

Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST)

ASIST is a two-day interactive workshop in suicide first-aid. Participants learn to recognize when someone may have thoughts of suicide and work with them to create a plan that will support their immediate safety. Participants don't need any formal training to attend the workshop – ASIST can be learned and used by anyone.

Goals and Objectives of ASIST:

- * Understand the ways personal and societal attitudes affect views on suicide and interventions
- * Provide guidance and suicide first-aid to a person at risk in ways that meet their individual safety needs
 - * Identify the key elements of an effective suicide safety plan and the actions required to implement it
- * Appreciate the value of improving and integrating suicide prevention resources in the community at large
 - * Recognize other important aspects of suicide prevention including life-promotion and self-care
