Recognized in SAMHSA's and the Suicide Prevention Resource Center's national registry of best practices, this training meets a portion of <u>Oregon House Bill 2315</u> requirements for suicide-specific continuing education for mental health professionals. Although many professionals use SafeTALK, anyone 15 or older can learn these life-saving skills and is welcome to attend.
