APPLIED SUICIDE INTERVENTION SKILLS TRAINING

Are you expected to help people in crisis or struggling to cope with life's challenges?

Build confidence in working with those feeling hopeless and thinking of suicide to help them find the part of them that wants to live and work on staying safe. ASIST is an evidence-based 2-day intensive, interactive workshop focused on de-escalating a suicidal situation and building a safety plan

Just as "CPR" skills make physical first aid possible, ASIST builds skills to create hope and safety – skills that anyone in a helping role or with higher risk populations needs.

This is an ideal training for faith leaders, emergency responders, mental health providers, school counselors, medical professionals, chaplains, corrections staff, teachers, coaches, veteran support staff, social workers, and community volunteers
